- Under the Tug Transition programme Jawaharlal Nehru port, VO Chidambaranar port, Paradip port and Deendayal Port, Kandla shall procure two tugs.
- The development of Green hydrogen hub at Tuticorin, Deendayal port and VO Chidambaranar port focusing on development and utilization of green hydrogen that is an environmentally friendly and sustainable source of energy.
- Single Window portal to monitor and facilitate river and sea cruises ensuring efficiency and seamless experience for cruise passengers and operators.
- Development of the Jawaharlal Nehru port and VO Chidambaranar Port and Tuticorin as smart ports by 2024 with advanced technologies digitalisation, automation and enhanced security and operational efficiency.
