MISHTI [Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats & Tangible Income]

- MISHTI is a new programme which will facilitate mangrove plantation along India's coastline and on salt pan lands.
- The programme will operate through "convergence between MGNREGS, Campa Fund and certain other
 sources
- This new programme will aim at intensive afforestation of coastal mangrove forests.



PM PRANAM

- It is the Prime Minister Programme for Restoration, Awareness, Nourishment and Amelioration of Mother Earth.
- It will seek to incentivise states and union territories promoting alternative fertilisers and the balanced use of chemical fertilisers.
- PM Pranam aims to ultimately bring down the government's subsidy burden, which is estimated to reach Rs 2.25 lakh crore in 2022-23: 39 per cent higher than last year's figure of Rs 1.62 lakh crore.
